She organized the first group of Volunteers for Carteret General Hospital. In addition, she was an active member and volunteer at First Presbyterian Church where she received “Woman of the Year” by the Presbyterian Women of the Congregation in 2004. She was a life member of the PKS Women’s Club. Mrs. Doremus was a national Flower Arranging Judge and an active member and early President of the PKS Garden Club.
